#### Usefulness




#### Relevance

### **Rhetorical "Rhet" Shot Engineering**




In this method, you go through each step to address the most important considerations to get an effective output from your AI Assistant. Each step influences the next. Then, you go back to the steps you need to refine your output. The goal is to get the most usable, accurate, relevant, and ethical output.


## **Push and Pull Prompting**

#### What is it?

A method of prompting your Al-Assistant where you "push" words into the prompt to get specific and "pull" words out of the result to get the most usable output.
