

## Minutes, HSS CFC November 17, 2010

Attending: Charles Aust (for Deanna Womack), Thomas Doleys, Melvyn Fein, Michael Firment, Mark Patterson, Richard Vehgroff (Dean), and Gerrit Voogt.

### 1. Approval of minutes.

The 10/27/10 minutes were approved.

### 2. Discussion of joint appointments.

The original controversies over faculty involvement in hiring faculty with joint appointments was due to a misunderstanding.

The Dean said that joint appointments must be approved by the department's faculty and that these appointments do not use up department faculty lines.

### 3. KSU and USG funding.

Funding will decrease because of loss of stimulus funding and probable loss of some student fees, funding may increase because of increased tuition and increased state revenue. The future is cloudy, but contingency spending plans at KSU are being developed.

### 4. Other matters.

If HSS funds are available for salary compression issues, they probably will not be used because of objections by the University.

Space limitations will be met for offices by the confiscation of hallway space. Friday and Saturday classes as well as hybrid classes will help with classroom needs. The enrollment is expected to increase 4 to 7 percent for next Fall.

### 5. Meeting schedules.

The Thursday meetings proposed by our Chair will not work for a high proportion of the CFC membership.
