

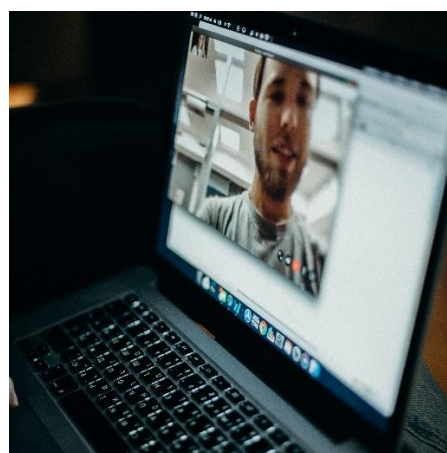
# Virtual Conversation Tables

Speak your mind · Build your skills · Meet your peers · Online!

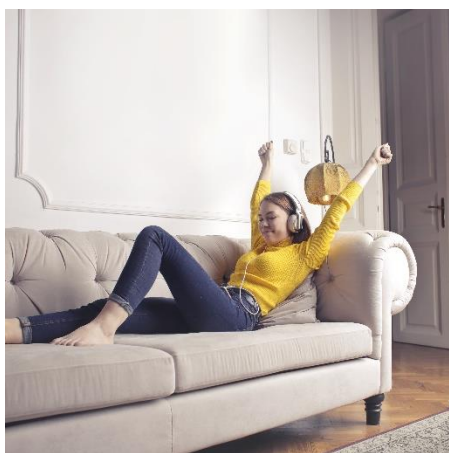

## How to Join a Virtual Conversation Table

1. Go to [flrc.kennesaw.edu](http://flrc.kennesaw.edu)
2. Click on **Virtual Conversation Tables**
3. Select your **language**
4. In the email that pops up, use your **kennesaw.edu email account** identify yourself and ask for the link to the VCT
5. The organizer will send you an **invitation link**
6. **Click and enjoy!**



## Tips for Successful Conversations Online



- **Test your microphone and camera** before you join
- Use a **headset or headphones**.
- **Look at the camera.** Place the video as close to your camera as possible
- **Speak clearly and be patient.**
- **Mute the camera** to help with a slow connection.
- **Mute your audio** when you're not speaking. This lessens background noise and helps everyone else hear clearly
