

Georgia Academy of Science Student Travel Awards

The Georgia Academy of Science is offering travel awards for graduate and undergraduate students to attend the **2024 Annual Meeting at Kennesaw State University**. Students chosen for the award will be informed of the decision by **February 14th, 2024**, and will receive a check at the banquet on Saturday at the conference. There will be ten \$100 awards.

To be eligible for the award, you must meet the following criteria:

- Be a current graduate or undergraduate student.
 - Undergraduate students who graduated in the summer or Fall 2023 are also eligible.
- The institution you attend must be more than 50 miles away from the meeting venue.
- Both oral presentations and posters are eligible and may have multiple authors. **However, only the presenting student is eligible for a travel award.** If two or more students plan to present one poster/paper, they will share the award money evenly.
- **Be present at the Friday and Saturday sessions and attend the Awards Banquet. You must be present at the Awards Banquet on Saturday to receive your check!**

You will need to submit the following information (by **December 4, 2023, at 5pm EST**). Late travel forms may be accepted at the discretion of the travel award committee. Please email Jason Lang (Jason.Lang@ung.edu) if you would like to submit a travel application after the 12/4/23 deadline.

1. The Student Abstract Submission form
2. The Student Travel Award Application form (**please scroll to page 2 of this document to retrieve the form**).
3. The Student Travel Award Faculty Support Statement form (**please scroll to page 3 of this document to retrieve the form**).
4. If two or more students on the same paper are applying for the travel award, each student must submit a separate application and faculty support statement (**i.e., completing pages 2 and 3**).
