### **36 hours for Non-Thesis option; 33 hours for Thesis option**

Non-Thesis Option: Electives (15 Credit Hours) + Demonstration Project course (3 credit hours)

Thesis Option: Electives (9 Credit Hours) + Thesis (6 Credit Hours) [**Note:** Contact MSCJ Director by midpoint of second semester of degree completion if interested in Thesis].
