

# Calculating your Psychology GPA

1. Consider **ONLY** psychology courses (PSYC prefix)
2. Assign the corresponding quality points (QP) below to each of your letter grades:

Letter Grade	A	B	C	D	F
Quality Point (QP)	4	3	2	1	0

3. Multiply the quality points (QP) by the number of credit hours (CH) for each course (QP x CH)
4. Add those numbers together (CH + QP)
5. Divide the sum of these numbers by the total number of PSYC credit hours overall

**Please see example below...**

Course	CH	QP	CH x QP
PSYC 1101	3	A (4)	12
PSYC 2300	4	C (2)	8
PSYC 3305	3	A (4)	12
PSYC 4455	4	B (3)	12
PSYC 4400	2	A (4)	8
PSYC 4410	4	C (2)	8
PSYC 3301	4	A (4)	16
<b>TOTAL</b>	<b>24</b>	<b>--</b>	<b>76</b>

**This student's Psychology GPA =  $76/24 = 3.16$**
