### General Procedures

2. If necessary, (like for the Interprofessional Cultural Citizenship Micro-Credential), speak with faculty from another department and have them sign this form [\[link forthcoming\]](#).
3. Work on your project! Let the faculty know if anything changes. Use the appropriate checklist below to verify you're meeting the requirements.
4. [Submit your project via this website](#).
5. Wait (patiently) as faculty assess your project.
6. Assuming you've met the requirements, celebrate with family and/or friends when you get the results. (Please hashtag #KSUDWLC on Facebook and Instagram.) [Select projects are posted to a special showcase on the department website](#).
7. Add the badge to your LinkedIn or portfolio.
8. Congratulations from the Department of World Languages and Cultures!

  - Engages the viewer while demonstrating understanding and cultural competency
  - Demonstrates level-appropriate skills in the target language
  - Any other information you'd like to share about it!

- Written Reflection (will not be shared) that:
  - Describes your motivation for the activity
  - Establishes the connections between the relevant discipline and language
  - Demonstrates level-appropriate language skills
- A Project (will be shared) that:
  - Describes your motivation for the activity
  - Explores and establishes connections between the relevant cultures
  - Demonstrates insight into cultural practices and perspectives
  - Demonstrate level-appropriate language skills
  - Engages the viewer while demonstrating understanding and cultural competency
  - Any other information you'd like to share about it!

You will be assessed based on your materials, the level-appropriate skills in the target language, and the quality of your project: engaging, comprehensive, and demonstrate cultural literacy. Your project demonstrates professional skills involving language, networking, synthesis and collaboration
