- A Project (will be shared) that:
 - Describes your motivation for the activity
 - Explores and establishes connections between the relevant cultures
 - Demonstrates insight into cultural practices and perspectives
 - Demonstrate level-appropriate language skills
 - Engages the viewer while demonstrating understanding and cultural competency
 - Any other information you'd like to share about it!

You will be assessed based on your materials, the level-appropriate skills in the target language, and the quality of your project: engaging, comprehensive, and demonstrate cultural literacy. Your project demonstrates professional skills involving language, networking, synthesis and collaboration

General Procedures

1. Speak with a [relevant faculty member](#) in the Department of World Languages & Cultures to plan your project and to discuss [which micro-credential\(s\) fit\(s\) your needs](#).

2. If necessary, (like for the Interprofessional Cultural Citizenship Micro-Credential), speak with a faculty member from another department to approve your project.
3. Work on your project! Let the faculty know if anything changes. Use the appropriate checklist below to verify you're meeting the requirements.
4. [Submit your project via this website](#).
5. Wait (patiently) as faculty assess your project.
